

**“OUR CLUB” SUPERDRAW
RULES 2022 / 2023**

1. The title of the draw is to be the **“OUR CLUB SUPERDRAW”** hereinafter called The draw.
2. The participating Clubs (hereinafter called the CLUBS) are, Pacific Palms Bowling Club, Club Old Bar, Laurieton United Services Club, Club Harrington, Wingham Services Club, Club Blackhead, Taree Leagues Club and Kendall Services Club.
3. The Draw is to be open to all financial members of the Clubs (members under the age of 18 are illegible to win). Every qualifying financial member of the Clubs is to be entitled to a membership card or alternatively a numerical accountable, instrument used as proof of membership. Entry into The Draw is free. One card per person. Every card is not assignable or transferable.
4. On duty staff members or Directors who at the time of the draw are providing a service to the club are ineligible to enter. This includes employees of any company associated with the promotion.
5. The **Card** is to have a Membership number.
6. Every new member of the clubs is to wait at least 7 days from the date of membership acceptance to be eligible for The Draw.
7. At the end of each clubs membership year the member is disqualified from The Draw if their membership is not renewed.
8. All clubs are to keep a record of the names, addresses and membership numbers of members. A central register containing all these details is to be held at and maintained by Laurieton United Services Club.
9. All clubs are to notify Laurieton United Services Club of all new members’ names, addresses, membership number each month following acceptance of the member to the club following the clubs meeting. Reports are to be emailed to dbonney@laurietonclub.com.au
10. All clubs are to pay Laurieton United Services Club a fee of \$300.00 per annum for administration expenses
11. The Draw is to be conducted on each Wednesday between the hours of 6 pm and 8 pm at Laurieton United Services Club.
12. Laurieton United Services Club will firstly draw for a participating club, then a financial member of that club, and then instruct the contact person of that club to announce the membership number and allow the member a period of four minutes to present themselves to the contact person in order to claim the jackpot. The member must be physically present at the time of the draw and at the club for social purposes. The member must also produce their membership card as well as personal ID in order to claim the jackpot. (A photo of the member with their membership card in the photo is to be sent to Laurieton United Services Club immediately for verification). Once confirmed a phone through procedure is then to take place to advise all other clubs of the result of The Draw.
13. The winning number and winners name is to be announced over each clubs in house P. A. System. The winner has 4 minutes from the time of the announcement at the club to claim the prize. The winner or unclaimed prize is also to be announced over each club’s in house P.A. System as soon as possible following The Draw
14. Each participating club will deposit \$1000.00 into an account held by Laurieton United Services Club to start the draw. The prize will start at **\$8,000.00** and will jackpot at **\$1,000.00** per week until the prize is

claimed.

15. The first draw is to take place on Wednesday the **23 February 2022** and will continue for a period of one calendar year from that date unless it is cancelled by a majority of clubs. On completion of one calendar year the draw will commence at 6.15pm until the prize is claimed. If at this draw, No winner comes forward by 10pm the Jackpot amount will be equally divided between the participating Clubs. Each club will then commence their own internal "Lucky Door 'style draw to include those members in attendance. After each attempt the entire draw procedure will take place again until the prize is claimed. After this draw a new permit will be in place for the next calendar year.
16. If at any time during the current permit the jackpot is won, the draw will restart at \$8,000.00 with each participating club to deposit an amount of \$1000.00 into the nominated bank account, with weekly deposits from then on to once again be \$125.00.
17. Prizes are to be posted to the winner in the form of a cheque within 7 days of the draw or by EFT payment.
18. All clubs are to pay **\$125.00** per week to Laurieton United Services Club which will be held in a separate account by Laurieton United Services Club and all cheques are to be made payable to that account. The Account name is to be **Our Club Superdraw**. When participating Clubs sign the agreement they will be bound to participate for the entire duration of the draw permit, ie each twelve (12) month period. **Any Club that falls behind in contributions by two weeks will be automatically suspended from any future draws until such time as they have paid all arrears owing.** There will be no notice given by Laurieton United Services Club. Each Club must ensure that payments are made on time. Agreements to participate in the Our Club Superdraw will be signed by each Club and filed at Laurieton United Services Club. All clubs are to do their own in house advertising.
19. Meeting may be called by any of the clubs at any time. Sufficient notice, being not less than 7 days, must be given to enable all clubs to be notified of the meeting. All meetings are to be held at Laurieton United Services Club.
20. One delegate is to be nominated from all clubs to attend meetings if required. The majority of clubs shall constitute a quorum. Should a quorum be not present after 15 minutes of the set date and time of the meeting those present and entitled to vote shall conduct the meeting.
21. A copy of these Rules is to be displayed prominently in all participating clubs.
22. In the event that a position becomes vacant by a club not being financial the draw jackpot will reduce by the amount that the outgoing club contributes and will increase again when that vacancy has been refilled.
23. The assets as well as the Liabilities of the account will remain the property of the Laurieton United Services Club.
24. If proposed prize money is greater than \$2000 the prize winner must be paid the amount exceeding \$2000 by a crossed cheque made out to the winner (or by EFT if the winner so requests). The full prize amount can be paid in this manner, if desired.

Draw Procedure

- Each **Wednesday** at 5.50pm the electronic random number selector will be programmed with the first number being **One (1)** and the last number being **One hundred & twenty (120)** representing the amount of minutes between 6pm & 8pm.
- At 5.50pm the random number selector will be activated giving the time in minutes after 6pm that the draw will take place.
- Five minutes before the draw time the Electronic Random Number Selector will be reprogrammed with the numbers **One (1)** through to **Eight (8)** representing the number of clubs involved in the draw. **(each club will be allocated a number between one and eight for the entire permit period)**
- At the draw time the membership of the club which has been selected will be programmed into the electronic random number selector and the member number will be selected.
- The club which the draw is related to will be the first club to be notified and Laurieton United Services Club representative will wait on the phone for a period of four minutes for advice of the presents or absence of the drawn member.
- The drawn member has **Four (4)** minutes from the time of the announcement and must produce their membership identification to the clubs representative in order to claim the prize. A photo of the winner with their membership card is to be texted to Laurieton United Services Club for verification.
- Fifteen minutes after the draw has taken place, **being reasonable time to notify all clubs involved in the draw** the winning membership number and respective club must be announced over all in house PA systems and the members will be advised if the draw will jackpot next week or if the prize has been claimed.
- The draw will be conducted in the Reception Laurieton United Services Club by a person appointed by the Secretary Manager and will be scrutinized by one other person.
- No members of Laurieton United Services Club will be advised of the outcome of the draw until the full draw procedure has taken place unless Laurieton United Services Club is the drawn club.

All forms relative to the draw will be completed immediately on completion of the draw and will be available for inspection by the authorities should the occasion arise.

Superdraw Second Chance Draw Procedure

On completion of one calendar year the draw will commence at 6.15pm until the prize is claimed. If at this draw, no winner comes forward by 10pm, the Jackpot amount will be equally divided between the participating Clubs. If at 10pm the draw has not been won, the 6 Clubs involved will divide the total between each Club.

If this occurs our Club will then start a draw with all members in the Club at the time receiving a ticket to go into the draw. The divided prize pool will then be divided again into 4 prizes. The first 4 tickets drawn will win.
