DAY 1: (MT, L, D) GUNNEDAH

Thursday 14 March 2024

This morning, we begin our journey into regional NSW, for a guided tour of some of the best Artworks in country NSW towns. This trip would not be complete without the Lightning Ridge experience which not only has some of the best Opals in Australia but is home to Artist John Murray's gallery as well as tremendous street art.

Today we depart Nabiac making our way to Gunnedah for our first night's stay. Enroute we will stop for morning tea, and the again for lunch at Willowtree. Our first Silo artwork will be viewed at a town call Barraba, just north of Gunnedah. This artwork was painted by Fintan Magee and depicts a local water diviner searching for groundwater. Dinner tonight will be at our hotel

DAY 2: (B, MT, D) GUNNEDAH- LIGHTNING RIDGE Friday 15th March 2024



This morning, we will start the day with a stop in at the Painted Silos and water tank at Gunnedah.

Here we will see a painting of Dorothea Mackellar and images of Australian soldiers from the Vietnam War. Time can also be spent enjoying the local museum and Dorothea Mackellar

Centre. On the road again we make our way to Narrabri for lunch (own expense) before heading on to Walgett and lastly Lightning Ridge. We will be spending the next 3 nights here.

Saturday 16th March 2024 DAY 3: (B, L, D) FULL DAY TOUR OF THE RIDGE

Today we showcase the local area on a full day tour. We collect our guide this morning and head to Grawin, Glengarry and the Sheep-yard areas. We also visit the War Memorial and Museum. A trip to Lightning Ridge wouldn't be complete though without the chance to fossick for opals. Who knows you might get lucky and turn up an opal! Later in the afternoon we will return to town with some free time or swim and relax in the hot artesian baths before dinner.

Sunday 17th March 2024 DAY 4: (B,L, D) MORE OF THE RIDGE



Today we will visit more of the local attractions in Lightning Ridge. At The Chamber of the Black Hand you will enjoy a selfguided tour of an old opal mine with a difference. This is an underground gallery with works carved and painted into the walls by the artist, Ron Canlin. This

an experience not to be missed. (Please note there are 84 steps to navigate to

get in to and out of the mine if you choose to participate). Next we stop at Bevan's Cactus Nursery where you will be amazed by over 2000 different species of cactus. Enjoy some free time here before we make our way into town for lunch. Our last stop is to the John Murray Art Gallery. His signature style artworks, depict quirky Australian animals with humour and satire all tied in. Lightning Ridge is fast becoming known as the street art location to visit in central

Australia. This afternoon we will have more time to visit the Artesian Bore Baths before dinner.

DAY 5: (B, L, D) THE RIDGE – BOURKE

Monday 18th March 2024

Today we make our way to the Back 'o Bourke but before we arrive we have some other points of interest to visit. Firstly, we will see the painted water tower in Walgett which features a tribute to Jimmy Little. Then we are off to Brewarrina for lunch. Brewarrina has recently joined a growing number of small towns that use murals to attract tourism to the town. Our final stop today is Bourke. This afternoon we will visit the Back O Bourke Exhibition centre. Here you will have time to explore this complex and learn about the history of the town through interactive installations and visual screens.

DAY 6: (B, L, D) BOURKE- COBAR

Tuesday 19th March 2024

This morning we make our way to the Darling- Baaka River, one of the most iconic rivers in Australia to board the Jandra Paddleboat. You will learn about the native flora and fauna and history of the riverboat era as you paddle down the river. We will also make a stop at the Back O Bourke Art Gallery and the Bourke Water Tower. Leaving Bourke, we make our way to Cobar in time for lunch. We visit the Information Centre and museum before boarding the coach for a guided tour of town and the must see sights.

DAY 7: (B, D) COBAR- DUBBO

Wednesday 20th March 2024

For our final night's accommodation, we will be stopping at Dubbo, but we still have more to see before we arrive. Our first stop will be at Nyngan where you can have a look around at the Nyngan Museum and the 'Big Bogan.' We will then make our way on to Nevertire and Warren where we view two more water towers. Lunch today will be at Narromine (own expense). We will arrive in Dubbo with time to relax and refresh before dinner.

This morning we will begin our journey home making sure to stop in at Dunedoo and Merriwa to view their silo art works. Lunch today will be spent at Denman before making our final leg of the journey home.
