

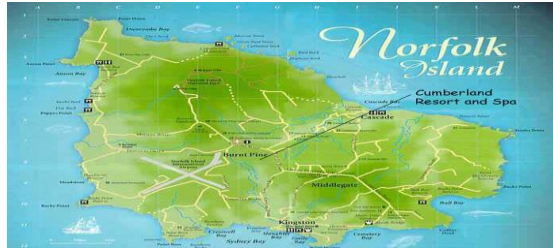

Day 1: Tuncurry to Sydney (D)

Thu 16th Oct 2025

Welcome to our Norfolk Island Tour. This morning, we will make our way to Sydney where we will enjoy a welcome dinner at our pre tour accommodation. This is a lovely way to kick start a fantastic holiday and get to know your fellow travelers. Lunch will be at your own expense en route to Sydney today. *Accommodation: Mantra Sydney Airport / 2 Course dinner Mantra*

Day 2: Sydney to Norfolk Island, Night as a Convict (B,L,D)

Fri 17th Oct 2025

This morning we will be transferred to the International Airport. On arrival at Norfolk we will be greeted by airport transfers and taken to our accommodation, which will be your home for the next 7 nights. A light lunch will be provided on arrival with time to relax at the resort. This evening we get into costume and dress as a convict and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing, and dancing. (*Outfit supplied*)- all you need to do is bring your sense of humour! And prepare yourself for a delicious meal with your new travel friends. This is Norfolk Island's only dinner and dance night - and one of our most anticipated events

Day 3: Island Half Day tour, Island Culture tour & Ghost tour. (B,D) Sat 18th Oct 2025

Welcome to Norfolk Island! A half day orientation tour is a must for every visitor!. On this tour, we will visit some key historic areas, including Kingston, Cascade and Longridge. This is your chance to learn all about the fascinating history of Norfolk Island. See the famous convict buildings for yourself and enjoy the stories told about these places. We will learn about Norfolk Island government, laws and of course their unique lifestyle. Some of the highlights include the renowned Melanesian Chapel and a visit to the grounds of an old island home, the arts of weaving, cooking, dancing and the Norfolk Language, inherited from their mutineer ancestors and their Tahitian wives. Join us for a cooking demonstration, a taste of traditional dishes, Tahitian dancing, and learn some of the Norfolk language they are so proud of. This evening we will experience a night of hair-raising tales and chilling encounters with the Norfolk Island Ghost Tour! Enjoy a delicious dinner in a beautiful Georgian building, followed by a spooky walk through the historic Kingston Ruins under the light of a lantern.

Day 4: Convict Settlement Tour and Murder Mystery Dinner (B,D) Sun 19th Oct 2025

Today we will enjoy an indepth tour of the World Heritage Listed Georgian settlement of Kingston. This whole area is a living showcase of Polynesian, convict and Pitcairn Islander history. We take you through the cemetery, old houses along Quality Row, visit the ruins of the new gaol, see the Pier Store, Boat Shed and the Crank Mill - all of which has to be seen to be believed. Lunch today will be at own expense. Tonight, we meet again for a **Murder Mystery Dinner**. Enjoy a 3 course meal fit for the commandants whilst the mystery unfolds. Audience participation is required for a guaranteed great, fun night out! (Don't forget your reading glasses!)

Day 5: (B,L,D) Paddock to Plate, Barney Duffy BBQ & Wonderland by night Mon 20th Oct

This morning, we will visit a market garden that supplies the Island with fruit and vegetables, a free range egg farm and a cattle farm. At each stop the farmers will tell you how they farm on Norfolk Island, and the challenges that this entails. Afterwards enjoy a sumptuous 2 course lunch in an Island home, showcasing our local produce. This evening we will enjoy a Wonderland by Night tour. We have enhanced your evening by including the Barney Duffy BBQ. Legend has it that Barney Duffy, an escaped convict, cast a curse on the soldiers who recaptured him. The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk Pines, which are lit up like a magical enchanted forest. Meander along (or ride in the 'moon buggy') through a gentle winding path with a descendant of the Bounty Mutineers.

Day 6: Greenfingers Tour (B, D)

Tue 21st Oct 2025

A day tour featuring some of the most stunning gardens on Norfolk Island is in store today. Throughout the morning, we visit a nursery owned and operated by a Norfolk Islander, and view the hydroponics. We also visit a gorgeous private garden with a spectacular view and Norfolk Islands only maze! Morning tea is also included, at a scenic location. Lunch today is at own expense. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at your leisure before meeting up for dinner this evening at our resort.

Day 7: Breakfast Bushwalk, Indulgence Tour & Progressive Dinner (B,D) Wed 22nd Oct 2025

This morning you have the option to join in a morning walk. Take your choice of a stroll through Palm Glen Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5 km walk through scenic Mt. Bates (the highest point on the

island! to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walks, we all meet up on the clifftop for a delicious breakfast barbecue. *(These walks are not recommended for anyone with medical conditions, good walking shoes required)*. If you would prefer to sleep in and skip the bush walk, but would like to have breakfast on the clifftop, you can join the walkers at Captain Cook Monument and share in the festivities. After breakfast your morning is free.

Our next tour is an Indulgence Tour on the south-eastern side of Norfolk Island, at Ball Bay. Here you will learn all about how Norfolk Islanders get their fuel ashore. We will finish the day the way all fantastic days should end - with wine, cheese & crackers on Mount Pitt. The Lookout gives a 360° view of the whole island, so it will be a picnic to remember!

This evening, we are going to experience a Progressive Dinner. You will enjoy a 3 course meal, progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. Each home has been carefully selected - and each dinner host has a sensational story to tell. You'll hear all about their family's history and day to day life. You will come away with a true insight on life on Norfolk Island and their beautiful people. *(White wine and juice is available to purchase- feel free to BYO other drinks. Tea and Coffee included)*

Day 8: Over the Cattlestops, Island Fish Fry & Sound & Light Show (B,D) Thu 23rd Oct 2025

Today we visit a few of the locally owned businesses that make up Norfolk industries. Norfolk Island has a huge amount of small businesses making different local products that we are able to see - and maybe have a taste of! We will also enjoy morning tea at a beautiful scenic location. Tonight we will enjoy the Norfolk Island Fish Fry. This fantastic event has been operating for over 40 years. Imagine - a feast of local dishes, salads and homemade coconut bread, alongside mouth-watering fried fish that you won't forget. Your feast overlooks breathtaking coastal scenery as the sun sets - with live music in the background. Your evening is completed by local entertainment from the *Baunti Byuutis* dancing group. *(Wine and beer are available for purchase or you are welcome to BYO drinks)*. Our evening will end with an amazing sound and light show.

If you require a disabled room, this will need to be advised at the time of booking and is subject to availability.

➤ REQUIRMENTS FOR TRAVEL TO NORFOLK ISLAND

- A valid passport is the preferred means of documentation; however, photographic identification is acceptable for Australian Citizens. We will be flying out of the International terminal
- You can only shop duty free if you have a valid passport.
 - Good walking shoes are required
 - Dressing for fancy dress night (convict clothes provided)

Luggage: Is limited to one bag not more than **20KGS**

Carry On: Is limited to one bag not more than **7KGS**
